However, if you misbehave you will spoil everybody's fun. We therefore have a yellow and red card system.

Yellow Cards will be given for:

Talking when you should be listening.	Messing around (including playing with footballs), wandering off or playing games on your iPad during activities.	Inappropriate language or name calling.
Ignoring the instructions of the leaders.	Damaging or destroying another person's property.	Messing around or talking during ceremonies and official events.

Five Yellow Cards in one term = miss 1 week of Cubs

Red Cards will be given for:

Fighting.	Receiving two yellow cards at one meeting or event.

One Red Card = miss 1 week of Cubs

Two Red Cards = miss 2 weeks of Cubs + meeting with your parents

Three Red Cards = you may be asked to leave Cubs

Lodge Leader, Sixers, Seconders, Patrol Leaders and Assistant Patrol Leaders will lose their stripes if they receive any Red Cards or regularly receive Yellow Cards.

Receiving Yellow Cards and Red Cards may also mean that you won't be able to come on trips and camps.
